Holders of passports of certain countries can obtain a Tourist/Business Visa directly upon arrival at the Rafic Harriri International Airport (RHIA) or any other port of entry at the Lebanese border on condition that there is no Israeli stamp on their passports.

Visas obtained at the airport cost \$35.00, are SINGLE ENTRY, and valid for ONE month only.

N.B.

- * Holders of South American passports that have proof of Lebanese origin are also included on this list.
- * Nationals of South America without proof of Lebanese origin are requested to contact the Embassy or any of the Lebanese Consulates to inquire about the details to obtain a visa.
- * These nationals should make sure that their passports do not have any mention of Israel on them; otherwise they will be denied entry into Lebanon.
- * Artists and other citizens of these countries who intend to work or perform in Lebanon are required to apply for a working permit at the Embassy or one of its Consulates.
- * Holders of Iraqi and Yemeni passports can be issued tourist visas upon their arrival to Lebanon via RHIA, if they hold two thousand dollars in cash, hotel booking, and a return ticket.
